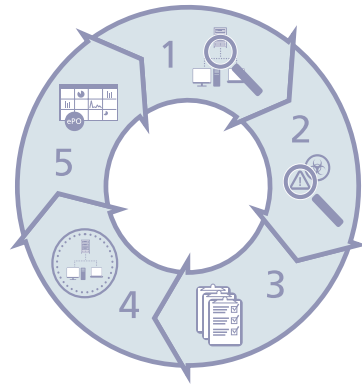

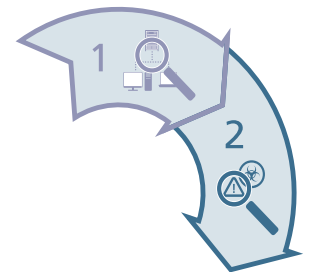
Step 1: Discover and Learn

Using **McAfee Network DLP Discover**, you can automate the process of understanding your information, how it is used and accessed, and the relationships between information elements. The solution swarms across your network and data center, interrogating all of your information sources to help you discover, understand, and classify your information according to your security policies.



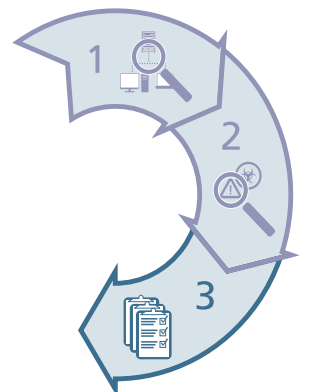
Step 2: Calculate Risk

Once you understand your information, you can assign levels of risk to particular assets. With **McAfee Network Forensics** you can correlate the latest threats against assets and information with regular network scans. You'll get persistent endpoint protection against viruses, malware, and intrusions. **McAfee Foundstone Professional Services** can help you conduct an internal risk assessment, and calculate and define risk due to potential data leakage or loss.



Step 3: Define Policies

Once you understand your risk, you can define the security policies to deal with the risk. For policy auditing, you need a good system of automated compliance checks to match internal and external governance regulations. **McAfee Policy Auditor** and **McAfee Remediation Manager** give you complete compliance auditing policies to ensure that you meet the latest regulations and standards. **McAfee Foundstone Professional Services** can also help you define your security policies based upon your risk assessment.



Step 4: Apply Controls

McAfee provides seven layers of core information protection controls at all key points of potential data leakage in the network:

- **Laptop and mobile device theft or loss**—McAfee Endpoint Encryption for Devices provides full disk encryption for laptops and mobile devices and renders sensitive data on them unusable in the event of data loss or theft.
- **Data compromise on workgroup servers or other shared systems**—McAfee Endpoint Encryption for Files and Folders encrypts individual files and folders on workgroup servers and desktops based on policy and automates encryption of files and folders on removable devices. McAfee Endpoint Encryption for Virtual Disks enables creation of portable, virtual encrypted volumes on Mac or Windows, sharable across platforms.
- **Data loss via removable devices**—McAfee Device Control monitors and controls user behavior with external removable devices to prevent information leakage or loss. McAfee Encrypted USB encrypts removable storage for power users in a centrally deployed and managed fashion. Also, McAfee Endpoint Encryption for Files and Folders with Removable Media Support automates the encryption of sensitive files and folders on third-party removable media and devices.
- **User behavior that could put vital information at risk**—McAfee Host DLP monitors user behavior with sensitive data at the endpoint (e.g., desktops and/or laptops) to prevent information loss and coaches users against behavior, or prevents it entirely.
- **External threats that could compromise the endpoint, including cybercrime and internal hacks**—McAfee ToPS for Endpoint is a collection of integrated controls designed to deal with external threats to the integrity of user endpoints including viruses, malware, host intrusions, spyware, phishing, and spam.
- **Data loss via email, web, IM, or other network communications**—McAfee Network DLP Monitor passively monitors all network traffic interpreting content and context to uncover and report on issues that could lead to information loss, even if you don't know anything about your information. McAfee Network DLP Prevent blocks all activities that would lead to information loss.

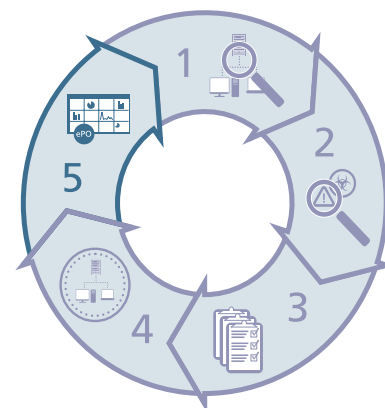


Step 5: Monitor, Report and Audit

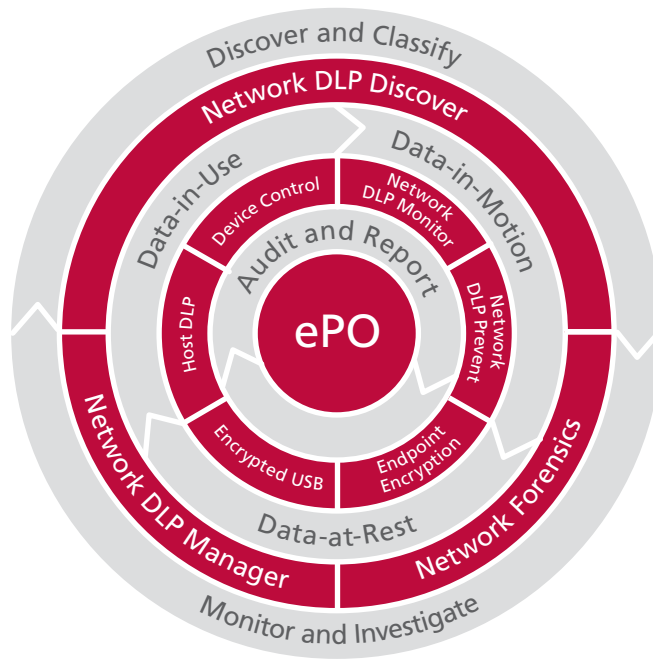
